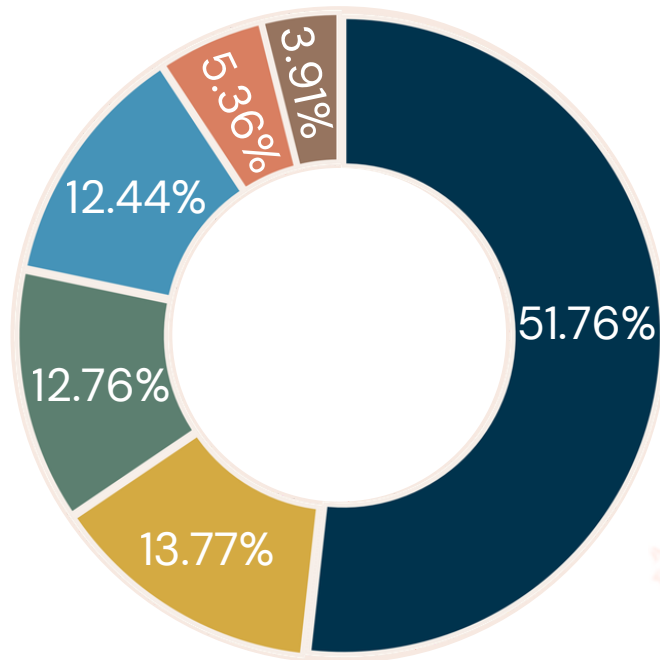
A Message from Pastor Randy

Missions Recap

"Our commitment to missions remains at the heart of Calvary Chapel Navarre. By God's grace, we continue to partner with more than 20 local, domestic, and global ministries, faithfully supporting those called to share the gospel both near and far.

This past year, we saw God's faithfulness in many ways. In the fall of 2025, God provided the resources to fund the construction of a new classroom at a school in Chimaltenango, Guatemala. In May 2026, our church served alongside Family Beach Fest on Pensacola Beach, and in June, a team of nine traveled to Guatemala to encourage our ministry partners at My Special Treasure and Precious Moments while exploring a new partnership in Santa Lucía Utatlán.

Throughout the year, our Mission of the Month initiative highlighted 12 of our ministry partners, helping keep our church informed and engaged in God's work around the world. We also launched Missions Hub on Church Center, creating a central place to share ministry updates, prayer needs, and reports from the field.

We are thankful for God's faithfulness this past year and look forward to continuing to support those He has called to the mission field while encouraging our church family to pray, give, go, and greatly love!"
